Our next **Moody Radio Alert** system test will take place on 10:00 a.m. CT on Thursday, August 1, 2024, on our email, web, and text messaging systems. (We stopped using the Moody Radio Alert Relay #6 on the XDS-PROQ receivers some years ago and now rely on emails, the [Moody Radio Alert website](#), and text alerts.) During the test, we will send a brief

message with the subject: "Moody Radio Alert: Only a Test." We will also post the test acknowledgment to our **Moody Radio Alert** website at: moodyradio.org/stations/affiliate/alerts.

The Moody Radio Alert system efficiently communicates satellite or FTP program distribution issues or short-notice changes in the Moody-1 program schedule. If you would like to subscribe to alerts, or if you have already subscribed, but do not see a message August 1, please email affiliates@moody.edu. Simply provide your full name, radio station call sign/name, and the mobile phone and/or email address you'd like us to send the alerts to. Thank you for helping us keep our Moody Radio Alert system up to date with your contact information.

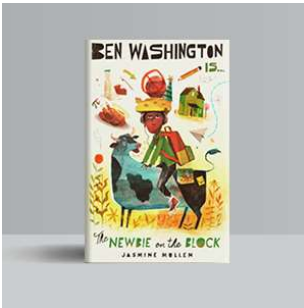

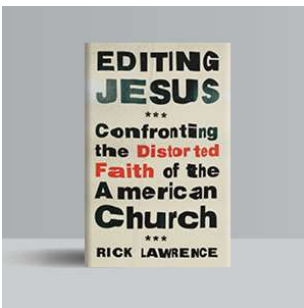

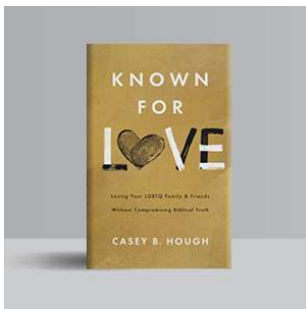
We need Jesus. The whole Jesus.

Updated Moody-1 Program Schedule eff. June 17 | Now Available

As announced earlier this month, **WORLD Radio News** will no longer be posted to the Moody Radio Affiliate FTP site, or the Moody-1 program channel after Friday June 14.

The new Moody-1 program schedule removes the six, 3-minute newscasts from **WORLD Radio News** on the Mon-Fri schedule effective June 17 at 5:55 a.m., 7:55 a.m., 9:55 a.m., 12:55 p.m., 3:55 p.m. and 7:55 p.m. CT. The newscasts have been replaced by a two-minute feature immediately followed by a one-minute feature.
