Mysteries of Easter in the Old Testament (2022), 54 minutes

Program Description: This special will guide listeners on a trek across the Holy Land. Through on-location soundscapes, dramas, and interviews with Israeli and Arab believers, they will encounter the story of the cross in a timeline that feels remarkably fresh yet is profoundly ancient.

Vinegar Boy (2002), drama, 55 minutes, no breaks

Program Description: In this Easter drama, a young boy, abandoned by his parents because of a ghastly facial birthmark, is taken in by Roman soldiers. He earns his keep in the commissary by supplying vinegar wine to condemned prisoners at Crucifixion Hill. He learns of a man called Christ, the healer, and seeks to find this miracle worker to remove his birthmark. Vinegar Boy's long-awaited encounter with Christ turns disastrous when the young man witnesses the healer staggering up toward Crucifixion Hill, himself a condemned "criminal." Thus begins Vinegar Boy's odyssey with the Christ of the cross. A professional cast and original music make this a not-to-be-missed program!
