## **Is It Time to Upgrade Your XDS Receiver?**


It may not seem like it, but it has been about 12 years since most Moody Radio Affiliates purchased their XDS-PRO1Q or XDS-PRO4Q satellite receivers. These receivers have performed well over the years, certainly outliving their five- to seven-year design lives. But the truth is that their manufacturer, ATX Networks, ended factory support for the "Q" model at the end of 2020.

This may be a good time to consider upgrading to the current models. The XDS-PRO1S (one audio port) and/or the XDS-PRO4S (four audio ports) would be the comparable replacement receivers. Moody Radio has favorable network pricing available to affiliates on these receivers, which can operate via satellite or IP mode. Stations need to export or log their local music data (anything that was not from Moody Radio) from this date range if they plan to use the Moody Radio Network music data for their station's 1st Quarter SoundExchange report due to SoundExchange by Wednesday, May 15. View Reports. The exact due dates for the 2nd quarter of 2024 and beyond SoundExchange quarterly reports have not yet been published by SoundExchange.
